


Dear Frazer Frontier Families,

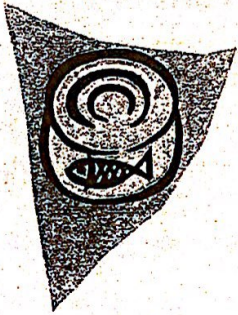
